Further to my site survey I confirm my recommendations and price to install temporary and cost effective bird repellent system to prevent feral pigeons roosting on electrical cable conduit and light fittings. These fittings are situated above the entrance ramp to the X-ray Dept door attached to the covered walkway support structure.

See photographs 1 and 2 below.

The pigeons are roosting on areas of missing bird repellent spike and where spike has been damaged on light fittings, etc.

Recommendations

We recommend the application of bird repellent spike to the roosting sites used by the pigeons. This will cover the light fittings, damaged spike area and a length of electrical conduits to the payment edge.

These works would be carried out on a Sunday morning using a tower scaffold for access.

Any pavement area contaminated with bird fouling would be deep cleaned and sanitised upon completion of works. See photograph 3 below.

Further to my recent survey, I confirm our recommendations and price for the above noted works.

Survey and Recommendations

A large flock of feral pigeons are using the cross beams, ledges, beams etc below the Helipad as a roosting and nesting site.

As a result of this pest bird activity the floor/roof walkways, ledges, fitments, etc are being contaminated with bird droppings.

The bird fouling accumulation is fairly rapid posing a Health & Safety Contamination and Slip Risk to anyone using this area.

The long term solution to this problem is the installation of a bird repellent system to deny the pigeon's access to the beams, etc. This is being assessed and quantified with a view to provision of a detailed quotation.

In the short term we recommend the regular deep clean and sanitisation of the pavements, ramps, ledges, handrails etc to minimise the build-up of the bird fouling. The frequency of deep clean will depend on the how rapidly the droppings build up, initially we would recommend a treatment every ten (10) working days.

All fouling would be removed from the recommended areas followed by the application of an appropriate biocide - Ornikill.

A fully comprehensive set of RAMS would be agreed prior to commencement of works.

Feral pigeons are roosting, perching on the decorative leading edge above the loading bay doors. The birds are using the vantage point to land on the ground at the doorways, when loading is in process, in an attempt to access the building. Bird fouling is also accumulating along the wall/ground edge below the roosting ledge.

GP Environmental recommend the installation of pigeon repellent spike along the entire length of roosting ledge (approx. 40m) to deny the pest bird access.

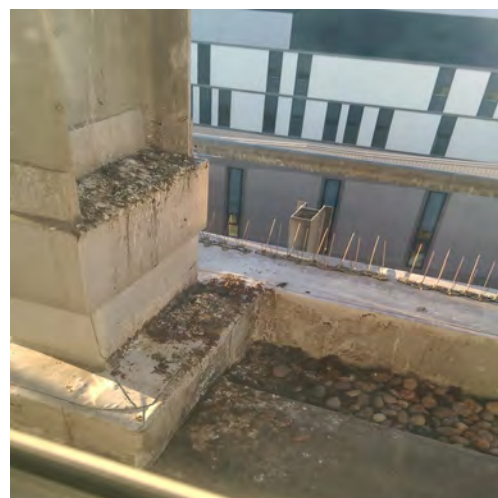
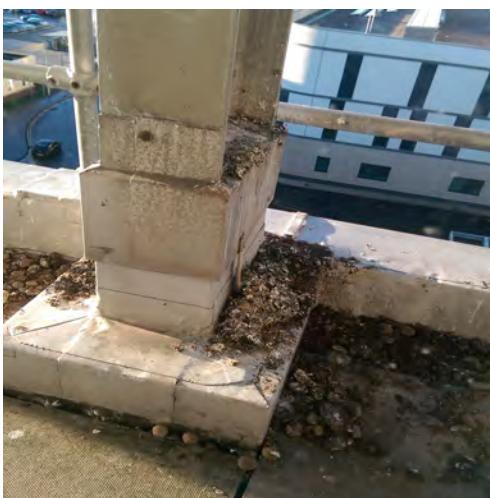

Further to my recent site inspection, I confirm our findings, recommendations and price for the above noted works.

A. SURVEY/RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Survey

Feral pigeon are using the bridge support beams as a roosting site and thereby fouling the beams and walkway below.

The birds have also gained access to the void space above the bridge base panels through a dislodged coping block and are harbouring in this space.

Feral pigeon fouling is present in many areas due to the amount of pest bird activity. The metal work, coping block and windows are badly fouled around the roof void space access point.

At the time of inspection (Wed 11th May) many lesser house flies were noted under and around the link bridge. The presence of these insects is as a direct result of the significant level pigeon activity.

2. Recommendations

GP Environmental recommend the deep clean and sanitisation of the bridge support beams and the external decorative bridge cladding ledge (running full width of bridge – see photos above), followed by the installation of pigeon repellent spike.

We also recommend accessing the displaced coping block at the bridge end to inspect the bridge base void space with a view to removing bird detritus, treat with insecticide and apply a biocide to the area subsequent to deep cleaning and removal of bird fouling, etc.

Following the above works and removal of bird activity we would re-instate the coping block and seal any existing bird access points.

A fully comprehensive set of RAMS and detailed programme of works would be provided and agreed prior to commencement of works.

Further to my recent site inspection of the MRI Dept and our pest control operative's extensive investigation into the Blue Bottle problem, the source of these flies has been established.

I confirm below our findings, recommendations and price to rectify the above noted significant Health and Safety Issue.

A. SURVEY/RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Survey

Staff of MRI Dept reported an issue with Blue Bottles/Lesser House Fly entering various rooms to the point where some areas were closed until the fly problem was dealt with. On inspection of the area (above and below the suspended ceiling tiles) it was noted that the insects were coming from one general direction which is the corner of room 085. Some ceiling tiles were missing in this room (now temporarily sealed) allowing the flies into the room and adjoining corridor below.

Our pest control technicians have established the source of the fly infestation which lies in the lower void space of the link corridor directly connected to the MRI Dept. To minimise the potential of continuous fly problems within the Main Building and MRI Dept, GP Environmental operatives have sealed the inspection access gaps around power cables, pipes, etc on a temporary basis until the source of the problem can be tackled.

The flying insect source consists of vast amounts of Feral Pigeon fouling, dead birds, nesting materials, etc, present in the Link bridge Lower Void Space. This seriously infested and fouled area exists between the link bridge ceiling above the roadway and the link bridges lower floor. The space contains cables and utility services but most of all 40/50 feral pigeon and associated detritus.

This level of feral pigeon numbers and depth of fouling has built up over time and is now a significant source of flying, biting and crawling insect activity which must be removed and denied the ability to re-establish.

2. Recommendations

GP Environmental recommend the permanent proofing of all haps from the Link Bridge into the buildings on either side of the contaminated roof void.

This would be followed by the removal of the “ceiling panels” to appropriate waste disposal and the deep clean and sanitisation of the void space (crossbeams, cables, ledges, etc)

Replacement ceiling panels would require to be installed by appropriately skilled joiners/ carpenters, however to prevent the birds entering the cleaned and sanitised void space, temporary bird repellent netting would be installed.

A fully comprehensive Programme of Works and RAMS would be provided and agreed prior to commencement of works. All works would be carried out during weekend day shift

when minimal traffic is present.

Due to the significant Health and Safety threat, this situation poses to staff and patients, we recommend that these works are carried out with some urgency.

A. SURVEY/RECOMMENDATIONS

1. Survey

A significant number of feral pigeons have infested the flat roof area above the front and rear entrances of the Maternity Building.

The many birds are nesting, roosting and fouling (heavily) these areas, resulting in 7-10cm of contaminated infested bird detritus coating the flat roofs and associated cable services, etc.

The extensive fouling, nesting material, detritus and many dead birds has resulted in the development of pest insects such as bird lice, lesser house fly, bird fleas, etc. It will only be a matter of time before these insects find their way into the building.

This entire pest bird issue poses as a significant Environmental Health and Safety Risk and requires Urgent Attention.

2. Recommendations

GP Environmental recommend an intensive deep clean and sanitisation of both the front and rear contaminated roof areas.

We would detail clean and remove all bird fouling, carcasses, nesting materials and contaminated loose timbers, etc. from site and dispose of appropriately.

Following the extensive deep clean and sanitisation we would install a pigeon repellent netting system which would "box in" the affected areas denying the feral birds access to the newly cleaned areas.

The netting would be installed on tension wires which in turn would be attached to only the concrete pillars/beams and the metal cladding.

This anchoring arrangement would avoid any interference with ceiling or wall insulation panels in this area.

A full comprehensive set of RAMS and a detailed Programme of Works would be provided and agreed prior to commencement of works.

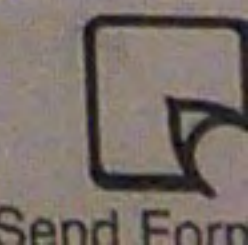

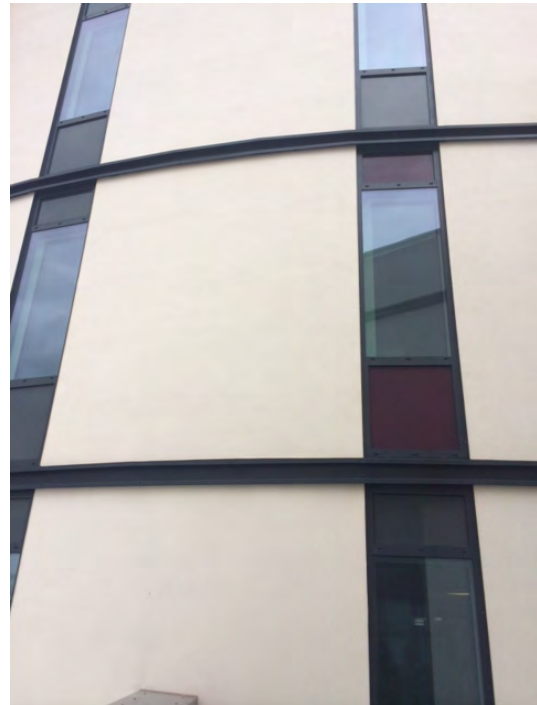

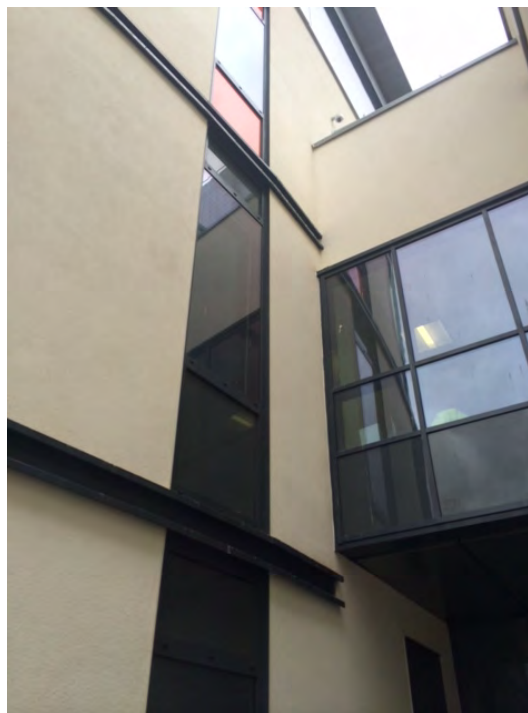

Further to my recent survey, I confirm our recommendations and price for the above noted works.

Survey and Recommendations

A large number of feral pigeons are using the cross beams, ledges, beams etc below the Helipad as a roosting and nesting site. As a result of this pest bird activity the floor/roof walkways, ledges, fitments, etc are being contaminated with bird droppings.

The bird fouling accumulation is fairly rapid posing a Health & Safety Contamination and Slip Risk to anyone using this area. The long term solution to this problem is the installation of a bird repellent system to deny the pigeon's access to the beams, etc. This is being assessed and quantified with a view to provision of a detailed quotation.

In the short term we recommend the regular deep clean and sanitisation of the pavements, ramps, ledges, handrails etc to minimise the build-up of the bird fouling. The frequency of deep clean will depend on the how rapidly the droppings build up, initially we would recommend a treatment every fourteen (14) working days.

All fouling would be removed from the recommended areas followed by the application of an appropriate biocide - Ornikill.

A fully comprehensive set of RAMS would be agreed prior to commencement of works.

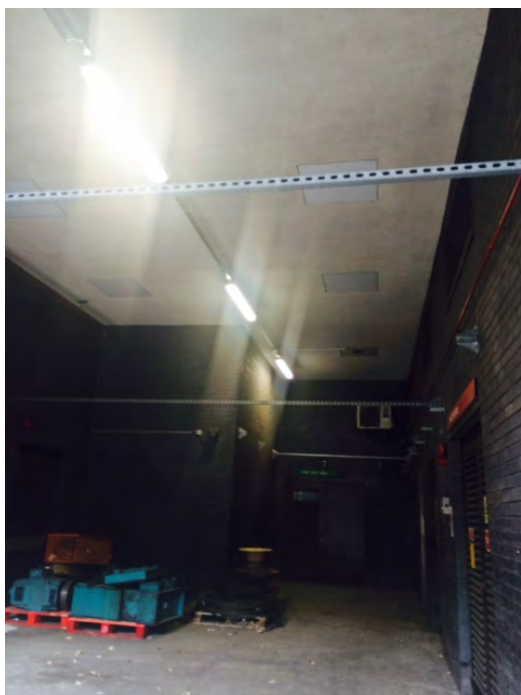

A. SURVEY/RECOMMENDATION

The newly installed lighting trunking will provide an ideal roosting and perching site for the many feral pigeons living in and around this site.

To deny the birds the ability to establish within this area the entire length (approx. 270m) of the new trunking requires to be “bird proofed” using a stainless steel appropriated sized bird repellent spike system.

This would be tailor-made to fit the gap above the new trunking and would be attached to the trunking using the recommended silicone adhesive.

The bird repellent installation works would be carried out between 9pm and 6am with a fully comprehensive set of RAMS and Programme of Works provided and agreed prior to commencement of works.

Access to the truing would be gained via portable access scaffold tower and MEWP for over the caged area.

B. FEE

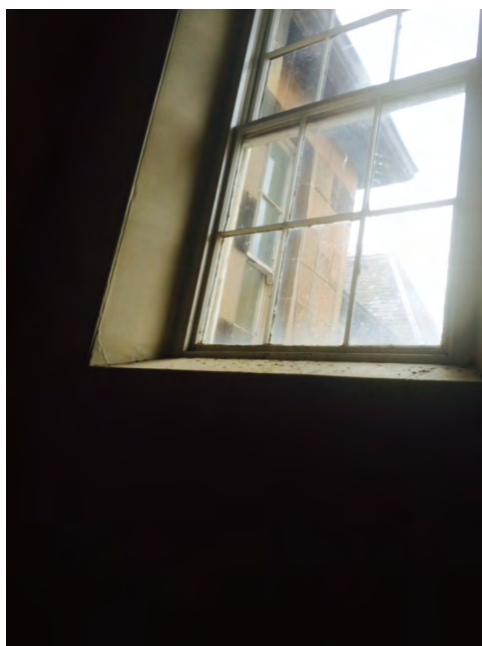

Further to my recent site survey, I confirm my findings, recommendations and price for the above noted works.

1. Survey/ Recommendations

a) Survey

A significant number of feral pigeons are using a rear window ledge and round structural beam to roost overnight.

This roosting is allowing the birds to heavily foul the ledges, beams, and more significantly the ground and walkways below.

The fouling has built up to be 4 – 5 cm in depth in some areas.

This bird fouling presents a significant Health and Safety Risk both from contamination (footwear, trollies etc.) and a slip risk.

b) Recommendations

GP Environmental recommend the deep clean and removal of all pigeon fouling from the ledges, beams, cladding and walk ways.

This would be followed by sanitisation of the cleaned areas and installation of pigeon repellent spike to the roofing ledges

The spike would be installed along the full length of the rear elevation from the access ramp to the last window before the corner of the building.

Access to the works would be achieved via a 2/3 stage ladders and portable Tower Scaffold.

A fully comprehensive set of RAMS would be provided and agreed prior to the commencement of works

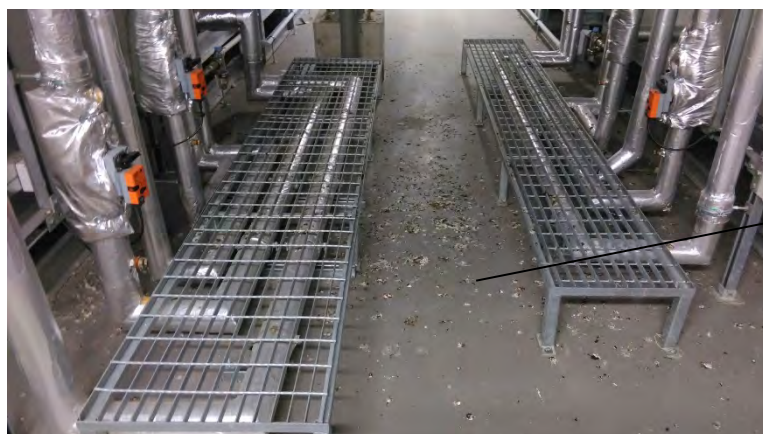

1. SURVEY/RECOMMENDATIONS

a. Survey

Pigeons have been accessing the plant rooms and walkways on the roof of the main hospital building. This has resulted in a heavy build-up of pigeon fouling on the ledges, beams, walls, floors and walkways of the plant rooms. The birds are have free access to these areas as the roof area is exposed.

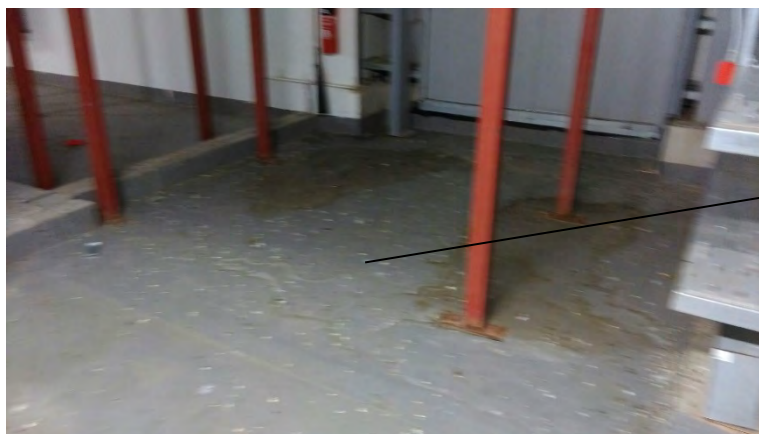

This fouling issue poses a Serious Health and Safety Slip Risk to anyone needing to use the plant room. In addition to this, the pigeon fouling is not only toxic, but provides a breeding ground for mites and insects which may ingress into the building.

This fouling is a result of birds gaining access to the plant rooms and walkways as the area is exposed to the outside. This provides an attractive, quiet, safe space for the birds to roost and perch. There are also various gaps around the plant rooms which allow bird access.

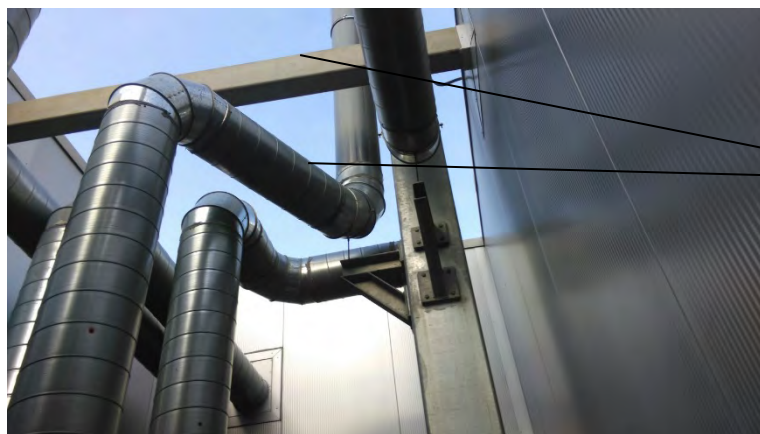

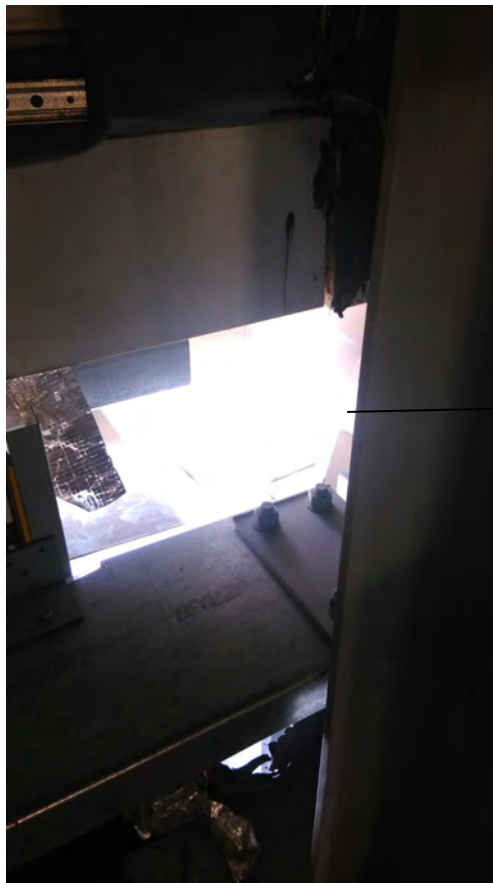

b. Recommendations

Initially we recommend the full deep clean and sanitisation of all fouled areas, beams, ledges, ladders, floors, walls etc, using a biocide sanitiser. All fouling would be placed into heavy duty refuse sacks and removed from site for appropriate disposal. The areas would then have a repeat clean of sanitiser to deep clean and leave the area safe for use.

To prevent the pigeons roosting here, we recommend the installation of bird repellent net systems to various areas of the plant room and walkways to completely exclude the pigeons.

This would involve the installation of 5 nets in total.

Net 1 - Walkway - 10m x 5m net installed to the area above the walkway ledges and

beams.

Net 2 - Walkway - 25m x 20m net installed across the top of the walkway.

Net 3 – Ducting Area - 15m x 10m

Net 4 – Ducting Area - 15m x 10m

Net 5 – Ducting Area - 15m x 10m

The nets will be installed using cladding bolts, tension wires and various other fixtures and fittings.

The areas will be accessed via the use of ladders and a small portable scaffold tower. The works would be carried out over 10 working days, and fully comprehensive RAMS would be agreed prior to commencement of works.

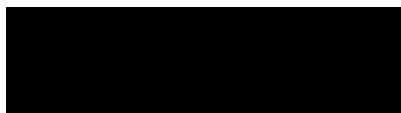

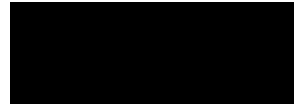

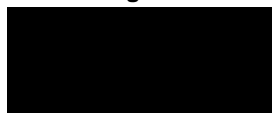

A) Survey/ Recommendations:

1) Survey:

Feral Pigeons are using the upper surface of the wall mounted spot lights to roost and nest build, resulting a significant accumulation of fouling and nest detritus below each one.

The birds are also fouling the equipment within the Food Waste Disposal/ Recycling Area contaminating the surfaces which site waste operatives are handling.

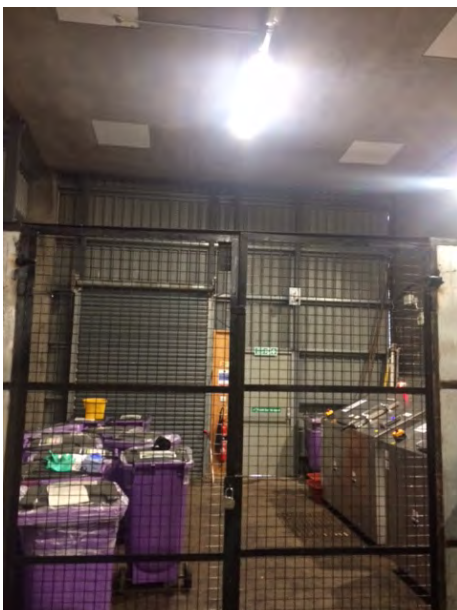

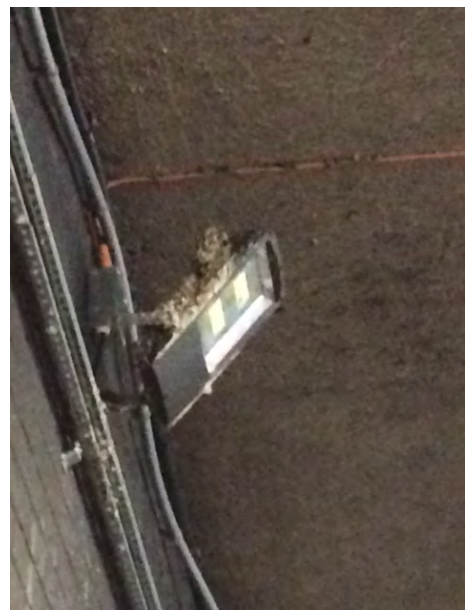

2) Recommendations:

GP Environmental recommends the deep clean and sanitation of all surfaces affected by the bird contamination. The deep clean would be followed by the installation of appropriate bird repellent systems (netting or spiking) to deny the feral pigeons the ability to return to the area.

A. Survey/ Recommendations

1. Survey

Staff of the QEUEH reported pigeon activity, and potential nesting of pigeons underneath the link bridge at the Neurology Unit. On inspection of the area, it was noted that temporary netting had been introduced to deter pigeons gaining access, however this has had little to no effect. Nesting materials, pigeon fouling and feral pigeons were noted on the underside of the walkway.

2. Recommendations.

GP Environmental recommend the cleaning & sanitisation of the underside of the link bridge, and the installation of permanent Bird Repellent Netting to the underside of the walkway, and the removal of any waste from the site. We recommend that the works be carried out on a Sunday, from 0800hrs to avoid any issues with surrounding traffic.

Further to my recent site roof survey I confirm our findings, recommendations and price for the above noted Gull Disruption Works.

A. Survey/Recommendations

Survey

Historical evidence of gull activity seems to be present on all roof areas on the hospital grounds. Many sheltered and secluded areas provide ideal nesting areas for the Seasonal Gull Infestation.

Recommendations

GP Environmental recommend that a Breeding Season Gull Disruption and Nest Removal Programme be carried out on the roof areas which display (at this time) the most evidence of a Gull Nesting Site.

The Gull Nesting Season commences at the end of March – beginning of April each year and continues until the last week of September. During the breeding season the gulls can produce two (2) or more clutches of eggs developing in some cases into four (4) or more juvenile birds.

It is during the presence of egg development and the resultant gull fledglings that the adult birds become aggressive to any passers by, hospital staff and roof technicians etc. To minimise the aggressive nature of the adult nesting gulls and to (over time) displace the birds a Gull Disruption Programme should be established.

This Gull Disruption Programme consist of regular site visits to remove gull nests and associated eggs thereby denying the development of any juvenile birds.

The programme consists of site nest removal exercise every fourteen (14) days from the first week in April to the first week in September totalling eleven (11) visits during the Summer Breeding Season.

Following a 3-4 year period of breeding season nest removal the gulls normally abandon the site for a “safer” nesting location.

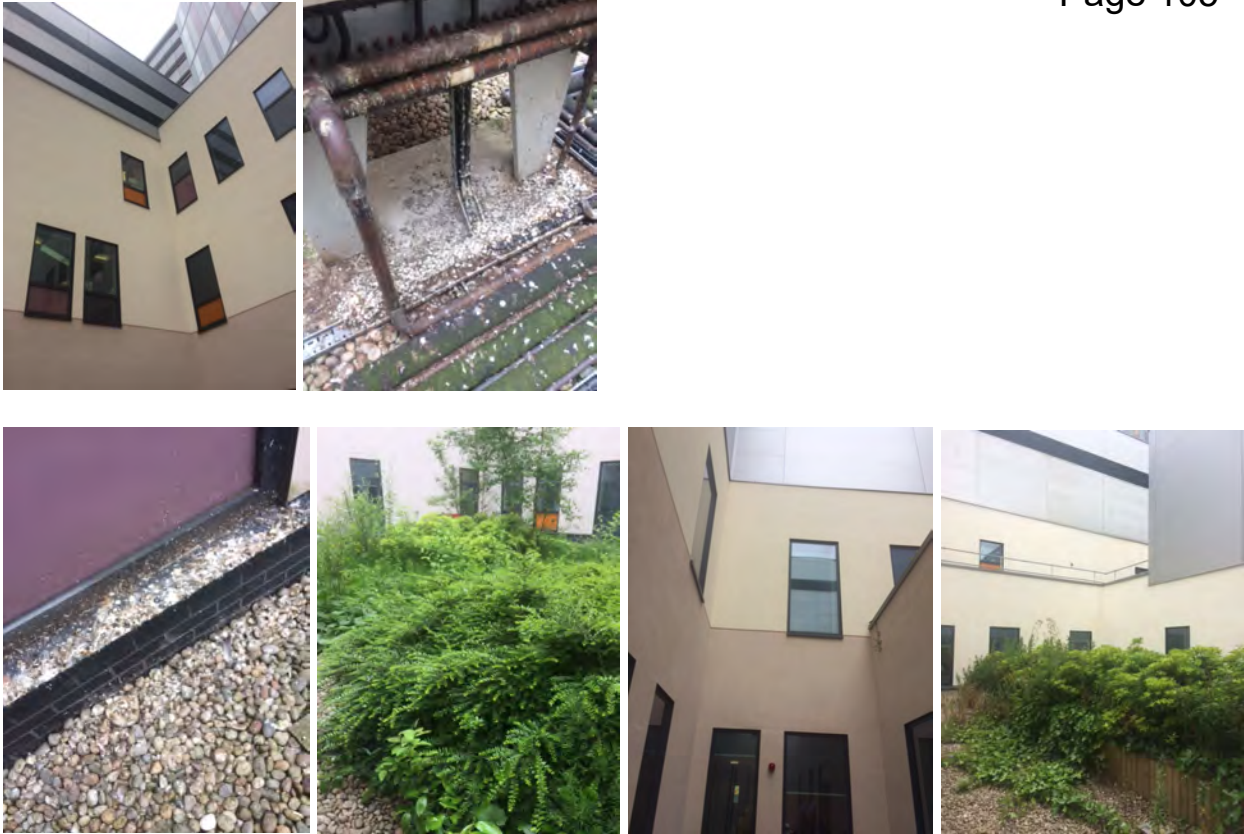

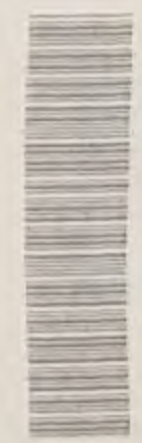

Further to my recent site meeting with yourself and Colin I confirm our recommendations and price to provide a programme of works which will have a major affect on the existing pest bird population.

A. Survey/Recommendations

A very large population of feral pigeons are present spread across various locations of the entire site.

The most obvious breeding site being the hollow beams and partially enclosed beams/ledges below the Helipad.

The sheer level of pigeon numbers are now posing a Significant Health and Safety Issue in many locations of the site involving walkways, plantrooms, ledges round the hospital external structure of the Main Hospital Building, Neurological Institute, RCH, Laboratory Block, etc and within site loading bays.

Control/Eradication Recommendation.

To provide a cost-effective feral pigeon reduction and control solution GP Environmental recommend the implementation of a pigeon trapping programme.

This Trapping programme would take place at various discrete/hidden roof locations across the entire site (approximately fifteen (15)) (See attached Proposed Site Plan)

The programme involves the use of metre square pigeon traps/cages in which pigeons enter to feed on a grain bait laid by a GPE Bird Control Technician. The birds enter through one way access points and become caged within the trap.

A GPE fully qualified pest control technician subsequently removes the trapped birds to humane dispatch and appropriate disposal.

The trapping programme would take place on a daily basis (Monday – Friday) over a six (6) week period. The first week would be pre-baiting, followed by another five (5) weeks consisting of four (4) weeks trapping and another one (1) week pre-baiting. All trapped feral pigeons would be humanely dispatched and disposed of in a discrete and appropriate way on a daily basis.

- I. Week 1 Pre-baiting
- II. Week 2 Live Trapping Programme
- III. Week 3 Live Trapping Programme
- IV. Week 4 Pre-baiting
- V. Week 5 Live Trapping Programme
- VI. Week 6 Live Trapping Programme

A daily report would be submitted detailing the number of trapped birds that were humanely dispatched from each of the site fifteen (15) cages.

After the last visit a Comprehensive Report would be collated detailing total numbers of bird humanely despatched and percentage of existing flock removed.

GP Environmental would expect to remove at least 80% of the feral pigeon population during a normal trapping programme.

A fully comprehensive set of RAMS and Works Programme would be provided and agreed prior to commencement of works.

Further to our recent meeting and site roof survey I confirm our findings, recommendations and price for the above noted Gull Disruption Works.

A. Survey/Recommendations

Survey

Historical evidence of gull activity seems to be present on all roof areas on the hospital grounds. Many sheltered and secluded areas provide ideal nesting areas for the Seasonal Gull Infestation.

Recommendations

GP Environmental recommend that a Breeding Season Gull Disruption and Nest Removal Programme be carried out on the roof areas which display (at this time) the most evidence of a Gull Nesting Site.

The Gull Nesting Season commences at the end of March – beginning of April each year and continues until the last week of September. During the breeding season the gulls can produce two (2) or more clutches of eggs developing in some cases into four (4) or more juvenile birds.

It is during the presence of egg development and the resultant gull fledglings that the adult birds become aggressive to any passers by, hospital staff and roof technicians etc. To minimise the aggressive nature of the adult nesting gulls and to (over time) displace the birds a Gull Disruption Programme should be established.

This Gull Disruption Programme consist of regular site visits to remove gull nests and associated eggs thereby denying the development of any juvenile birds.

The programme consists of a site nest removal exercise every fourteen (14) days from the first week in April to the first week in September totalling eleven (11) visits during the Summer Breeding Season.

Following a 3-4 year period of breeding season nest removal the gulls normally abandon the site for a "safer" nesting location.

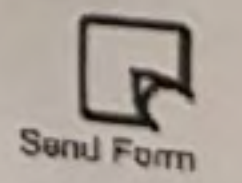
